### JOB SUMMARY:

- Completes **HVAC maintenance operation requirements** by scheduling and assigning employees; following up on work results.
- Responsible for compliance with OSHA requirements and the company safety program.
- Skilled in various mechanical, painting, plumbing, carpentry, and electrical skills.
- Monitors facility systems and equipment, and makes adjustments and repairs as necessary.
- Must have the ability to operate heavy equipment.
- Complies with required codes and standards by directing and monitoring, and inspecting systems and equipment.
- Implements changes, expansions, and additions to systems and equipment by identifying problems; keeping abreast of new developments.
- Must be able to operate heavy equipment.
- Assists with set up for special events.
- Performs other job-related duties as assigned.
